FROM THE JOE ZONE

The excitement you feel is the upcoming 25th season of the NR/CTPA. The WORLDS and the Super Pull will both be celebrating their silver anniversaries this year. A quarter of a century of Radio control competition.....I cannot think of any other R/C event that has gone on that long. So we must have the longest running R/C events in the world. The entry forms for the Super Pull are in this edition. The new rulebook will be out soon and will be distributed at the Super Pull and all of the events after that...if you need one sent to you please let me know we can mail it out...although it is way cheaper to hand them out. We will also have a email copy of the book and it will be on the website.

CARPET PULLING.....new rule changes for the 4wd pro-mod class have been passed to allow more tires than that discontinued venom tire. and you may cut those 4wd tires too.

As of this writing we are unsure of the direction, but we may wind up just using the Garden Tractor rules so at least there will be scale tires for those trucks. The ongoing problem is the tire availability for the carpet classes. Natural rubber Foam tires are only available from old stock that some guys still have and now we have this Venom tire problem. (Venom quit making this stuff in 2005 I am hearing) 2wd Open 2's can now use brushless motors and lipos....again tires are a problem here too but at least we straightened out the motor and batteries this time. I feel it will take more than just the executive board to bring back carpet pulling it will take the members who pull these classes to work together and help us out a little.

RACING: First results of the promotional package we offered at iHobby are real good. We hope that this translates over to at least 8—12 new guys making it to the SPRINGS this year. With these new members I believe we can really turn the corner here and get back to the huge numbers we used to get with that venue. Racing has been the focus of the board for a long time now...we would hope some of the work that has gone into this starts showing results. I think it already has.

DIRT PULLING: The only problem we have with dirt pulling is a new class or 2 crops up every year....We have a ton of dirt classes. I guess it's a lot of ways to enter and a lot of ways to win. It is

really only *barely* a problem only if nobody enters that class. We have to hope that the pre-registrations are pretty much the complete number of entries. The association really wants to have an award there for every class. If it is vacant at pre-registration we have to hold our breath that nobody enters it because we don't get the awards and at the event. Bent fenders there... The only way that could get fixed is that everyone please PRE ENTER I guess....then we won't have to guess...there was some discussion on looking back over the years to see the average turn-out and seeing if that doesn't warrant awardsagain we are guessing.

THE HOTEL: Hotel room nights are going up 15 bucks a night. That is still way under the "hotel average" of \$100 a night. We have some creative ways of paying for the new atrium rates that now include setups and cleanups. We used to be @ 700 it is way beyond that (1600) but with creative book keeping we were able (if everything goes like is should) get it still for that. They have a 10 per room night that gets subtracted from the atrium bill. The hotel is being run now by a consulting firm and they want to show money made...We signed 4 event deal so we shall see.

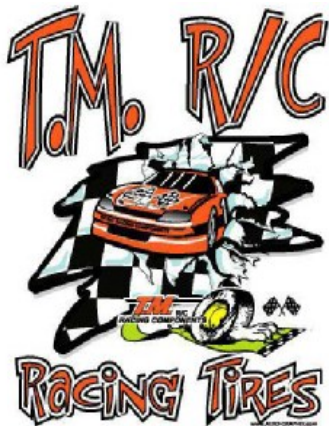

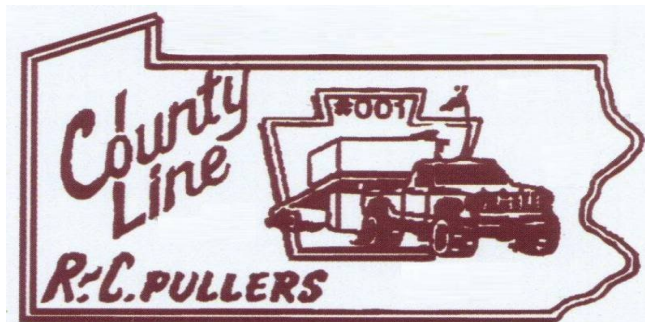

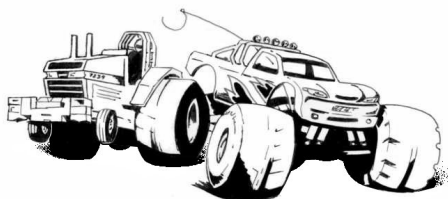
