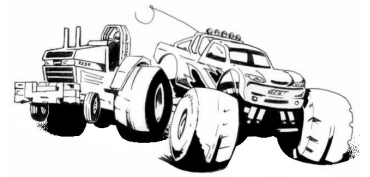

C Pulling – Continuing to Grow

This summer the STPA held events at the Richwood OH fairgrounds in association with the Delynn Kale Memorial pull (full scale OSTPA event) on July 6, and also in Ashland OH at the Yesteryear Machinery show July 13 and 14 (lots of old tractors, mowers, and one-of-a-kind vehicles from ¼ scale tractor replicas, and custom made multi-cylinder miniature engines to VW powered log splitters). The Biggest event for the STPA this year was at the National Tractor Pulling Championships in Bowling Green Ohio. We pull RC just behind the main grandstand on the Wood County Fairgrounds just before each of the two full-scale pulling sessions on Friday and Saturday August 16 and 17. We are in a prime spot in terms of exposure and get many hundreds of spectators throughout the weekend. Joe has posted a great video of this event as part of his Joe Show series (check it out for a “virtual experience” of this fantastic event). Our most recent pull was at West Liberty Ohio during what has become an annual experience on Labor Day weekend.

This year for the first time the STPA will be hosting a RC Pull at the Enderle Pull Off on September 14 and 15. This is located in Urbana, Ohio at the Champaign County fairgrounds. I’ve attended the full-scale Enderle Pull Off as a spectator for many years and I highly recommend it as one of the Best NTPA pulls around. It is an invitational pull that limits entries to basically the top 5 in the NTPA Grand National points, plus a couple competitors from regional levels. So it’s just the best of the best. There are two tracks and the entire pull is over in about 4 hours. In terms of the RC pull, the STPA will also be running two tracks and pulling on Saturday and Sunday inside the Show Arena. Come and join us for the inaugural RC pull at Enderle. After that, we will pull at Xenia, Ohio, and then it will be on to the NRCTPA Worlds event.

I proposed a rule change at the 2013 Springs regarding the starting of engines off the track (under the smoke machine at the starting bench). Basically this is to allow the kind of off-track start-up and carry to the track that was temporarily permitted when our friends from the Netherlands came over a few years ago. I’ve been working with the Dutch in an effort to come up with an International Modified RC class for vehicles similar to those that run in the class we call “Insane” here in the states, and this proposed rule change is part of that effort to help facilitate that type of class, and support the growth of multi-engine RC pulling vehicles here as well. I ask for your support of that rule change that would essentially just “officially permit” what we have already done at times. If you have any questions about this, please let me know.

There are a lot of great pulling events coming up so get your stuff ready and hit the road.

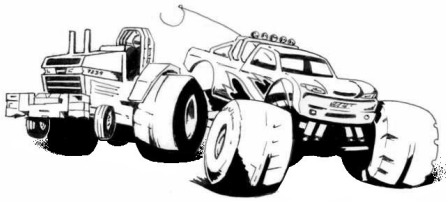
